I hope you enjoyed former member Lynda Miller's presentation on her iris hybridizing. She's developing some beautiful flowers. She donated some of her introductions that were auctioned and will be donating some more for our September meeting.

This month our speaker will be Peggy Harger Allen presenting "Japanese Iris", showcasing the beautiful Japanese iris - Hanashobu which were featured at the American Iris Society's National Convention in 2024. Her presentation will also qualify as a judge's training for those who want it. Peggy divides her time between bird watching and gardening. Both her mother and grandmother grew iris and they became a favorite flower in the 1950's. Peggy joined IDIS in 2005 and started studying iris seriously at that time. Today she grows about 350 varieties of iris as well as 150 daylilies. She particularly likes dark iris and historic iris. Her garden in an official display garden of the Historic Iris
