A motion was passed at our June meeting, asking the Board to revise the Bylaw guidelines for the Nominating Committee so that if the slate could not be filled with members of at least two years (current requirement), members of at least one year could also serve. The following (in red) is the suggested revision to the Nominating Committee description which will be voted on at the August 1 meeting:

NOMINATING—This committee consists of three (3) members who shall be appointed by the President at the April meeting. It is recommended that officer positions be filled with those who have been members of IDIS for at least two (2) years when possible. The Chairman shall announce the slate of nominees at the June Membership meeting. Nominations may also be made from the floor at the June meeting, however, those nominees must be present at the meeting to accept the nomination. The Chairman shall present a slate of nominees for officers again at the August Membership meeting for election by a two-thirds vote of the members present.

Jeanette Blackstone reminds us to wear our name tags at our meetings. If you have yours at home, please bring it along. If you don't have a name tag, please let Jeanette know and she'll get one made.
