auction. Hopefully more of our members will be able to attend at this location. We will evaluate the location again at the end of the year and welcome your input.

Laurel Richardson has lined up some great speakers for 2025. Our opening speaker on Tuesday, March 4 at 6:30pm will be a former member, Lynda Miller. Over 18 years ago the Millers (2006 Roger, 2007 Lynda and Nathan) left the long, cold, and dreary winters of Indiana to pursue the dream of living in plant heaven, Oregon. Lynda is a longtime iris hybridizer, having introduced over 250 iris. Her introduction, Football Hero, won the Dykes Medal in 2022, the highest award from the American Iris Society. She specializes in Miniature Tall Bearded and Tall Bearded Iris. True Miniature Dwarf Bearded iris are also a favorite project. Her iris garden is limited to nearly an acre with her TB seedlings being forced off-site for their maiden bloom. Space limits the collection to approximately 600 registered varieties and 300+ selected seedlings in the valuation process. The iris are grown in long rows to allow for cultivation and are all dug each year with only 2 or 3 rhizomes per variety retained. Currently nearly all dwarf and median seedlings make their first appearance in the home garden. Lynda's introductions are available at Mid-America Gardens. Please join us as she shares about current developments in iris hybridizing.

We will again have a free educational booth at the Indiana Flower & Patio Show, March 15-23. The show opens each day at 10am and usually closes at 7 or 8pm. Might you have four hours of time to volunteer at the booth? This is a qualifying volunteer activity toward our NCAP and Registration Refund programs. You get free admission and can visit the many other booths when you're not working. There will be a sign up sheet at our March meeting.

There are some things to note this year. 1. We will have a Daylily Show on Saturday, June 28 at Avon Gardens. There will be no Iris Show this year. 2. The NCAP daylily distribution will be at our May 13 meeting. There will not be a speaker that evening. Lezlie is ordering plants from Brown's Ferry Gardens (Heidi and Charles Douglas). 3. Our Iris NCAP distribution will be at our August meeting. Peggy is ordering plants from Mid-America Gardens. 4. We will again hold our August plant sale at Avon Gardens. 5. We are fortunate
